

Is It Time To Intervene? Driving Quiz

Is it time to take action regarding your parent or partner's driving? Take this quiz to get a better idea.

Rate each statement TRUE or FALSE:

- TRUE/FALSE My parent or partner appears to feel confident and comfortable when driving.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *at night*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *in the rain*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *in the snow*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *in fog*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *on icy roads*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *on the freeway*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *in heavy traffic*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *in remote areas*.
- TRUE/FALSE I feel safe as a passenger when he or she is driving *on mountain roads*.

- TRUE/FALSE He or she has never gotten *lost or disoriented* when going to the grocery store or other familiar location.
- TRUE/FALSE He or she has never gotten *lost on the way home*.
- TRUE/FALSE He or she doesn't *randomly speed up or slow down*.
- TRUE/FALSE He or she doesn't *drift lanes*.

Scoring

All TRUE	Ask another family member to do the quiz also. Compare your answers. If you both score all TRUE answers, congratulations! Driving doesn't appear to be an issue you need to deal with at this time.
1 or more FALSE	It's time to intervene.
